Academic Regulation: [At least 128 credits are required for graduation] (1) A. General Required Courses: 30 credits, including: "Professional Competence General Education: 6 credits", "Liberal Arts General Education: 10 cred-its", "Foreign Languages: 6 credits (English I, English II, Foreign Language)", "Chinese: 4 credits (Chinese I, Chinese II)", "Information Courses: 4 credits (Basic Programming, Application Software)", "Physical Education: 0 credits", "National Defense Education and Military Training: 0 credits", "The Way of the University: 0 credits", "Labor Education: 0 credits" Professional Competence General Education: 2 credits in Business Ethics, 2 credits in Innovation and Entrepreneurship, and 2 credits in Workplace Writing. These can only be taken from sophomore year onwards. Liberal Arts General Education: 2 credits from each of the following categories – Culture, History & Arts; Society & Civic Literacy; Natural Environment & Technology; Life & Health Literacy; and Yuanpei Book Institute. A total of 10 credits. (2) B. Major Required Courses: 36 cred-its G. Group Required Courses: 12 credits A total of 48 credits from B and G combined. (3) C. Major Elec-tive Courses and H. Department Module Elective Courses A total of 50 credits from C and H com-bined. (4) Students are required to take at least 4 credits from courses outside their de-partment but no more than 10 credits will be recognized. (5) Other requirements: Students must follow the departmental course regulations (6) Students must meet the graduation requirements listed in Project 1311 in order to graduate.
