Academic Regulation [At least 128 credits are required for graduation](1) A. General Required Courses: 28 credits, including: "Professional Competence General Education: 6 credits", "Liberal Arts General Education: 10 credits", "Foreign Languages: 6 credits (English I, English II, Foreign Language)", "Chinese: 4 credits (Chinese I, Chinese II)", "Information Courses: 2 credits (Basic Programming)", "Physical Education: 0 credits", "National Defense Education and Military Training: 0 credits", "The Way of the University: 0 credits", "Labor Education: 0 credits". Notes: Professional Competence General Education: 2 credits in Medical Ethics, 2 credits in Innovation and Entrepreneurship, and 2 credits in Workplace Writing. These can only be taken from sophomore year onwards. Liberal Arts General Education: 2 credits from each of the following categories – Culture, History & Arts; Society & Civic Literacy; Natural Environment & Technology; Life & Health Literacy; and Yuanpei Book Institute. A total of 10 credits. (2) B. Major Required Courses: 87 credits G. Group Required Courses: 0 credits: A total of 87 credits from B and G combined. (3) C. Major Elective Courses: 13 credits H. Department Module Elective Courses: 0 credits A total of 13 credits from C and H combined. Courses from the same major and department taken by students may count towards the required elective credits for the major. (4) A maximum of 10 credits will be recognized from courses taken outside the department. (5) Students must meet the graduation requirements listed in Project 1311 in order to graduate. (6) Students must choose one clinical practice from various nursing specialties in order to graduate.
