Academic Regulation [At least 128 credits are required for graduation] (1) A. Common Core Courses: 28 credits, including: "Vocational General Education: 6 credits", "Liberal Arts General Education: 8 credits", "Foreign Languages: 6 credits: English I, English II, English III", "Chinese: 4 credits: Chinese I, Chinese II", "Information Technology: 2 credits: Introduction to AI Programming", "Physical Education: 2 credits", "Military Training in National Defense Education: 0 credits". ※Vocational General Education: Medical Ethics (2 credits), Multidisciplinary Innovation and Entrepreneurship (2 credits), Workplace Documentation (2 credits); available only to second-year students and above. ※Liberal Arts General Education: Students must select from four categories-Culture, History, and Arts; Social and Civic Literacy; Natural Environment and Technology; Yuanpei Academy; and Self-Directed Learning-for a total of 8 credits. (2) B. Professional Core Courses: 87 credits. (3) C. Professional Electives and Cross-Department Electives: Up to 10 credits are recognized, with a total of 13 credits required from C and cross-department electives. Elective courses within the same program may count toward the required professional elective credits. (4) Students must meet the graduation requirements specified by Project 1311 to graduate. (5) Students must complete clinical training by selecting one course from each clinical nursing specialty in order to graduate. (Approved by the University Curriculum Committee on 113.02.15, 113.06.18, and 113.08.20)
